

Senior Portfolio Project Part 2

Now that you have worked with electronic music, it is time to create your own piece. Using Computer Software, create an all electronic piece of music. Use sounds you find on the internet, or create a sound using the computer programs in the lab computers. Maybe record yourself or a sound that you like and use that in the piece. Be experimental, creative, and most of all, have some fun with it!!!!

Guidelines:

1. Minimum of 45 seconds
2. Come up with an outline score, similar to what you created for *Hibiki-Hana-Ma*
3. Find sounds online, a good site is www.freesound.org
4. Must be able to show me your work in the computer software
5. Try using Audacity, Logics, or any other software you feel comfortable with
6. Be unique and different, try to experiment
7. The more creative and experimental you are, the higher the grade
8. Save all of your work on a Thumb or USB drive

Requirements:

1. Use at least 3 separate tracks
2. Fade in and out all sound clips to produce a clean sound without pops
3. Manipulate volume
4. Manipulate panning
5. Manipulate timbre of your sound clips

Make sure that you think of this as a piece of music. Beginning, middle, end. Climax/Resolution. Tonal/Atonal. Also, make sure to use many different electronic techniques to change your audio.

This will be one of two audio files that you will turn in at the end of the semester as part of your portfolio. Remember the first file will be an audio recording of a composition or performance by you.
