-The relationship of the parts to each other and the whole work

-Because it has to do with one part compared to another, the artist just consider the scale of the objects/people

- By placing an object in the foreground, middle ground, or background, you give a clue to its size and distance

Two types of proportion

1. Standard

-A person/object with appropriate height weight and depth compared to its surroundings

2. Altered

-A person/object whose proportions have been changed

-Can give an eerie sense of unreality

-Exaggerated proportions show emphasis
