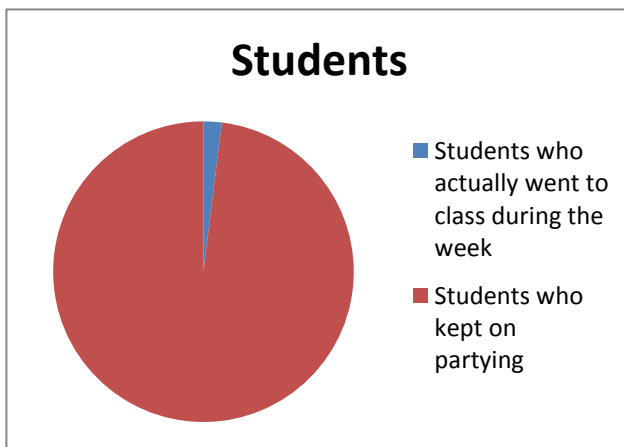
The Lasallian Festival

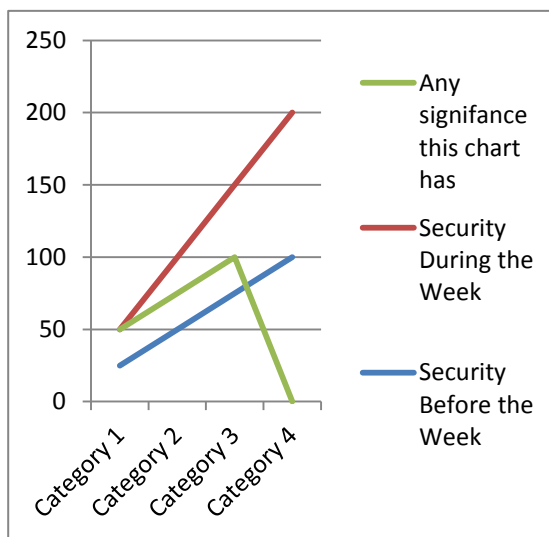
